


- It's important your child feels comfortable expressing any concerns or anxiety he or she may have about returning to school.


#### Baisakhi & Inter-House Solo Dance Competition (Jr.) - 13 April 2023









#### World Press Freedom Day - 3 May 2023

The students of classes XI and XII visited International Museum Expo and gathered a lot insights and information about the past and the latest trends in the world











#### Fire Drill Activity - 26 May 2023




















#### Kargil Vijay Diwas - 26 July 2023















### Janmashtami – 6 September 2023


