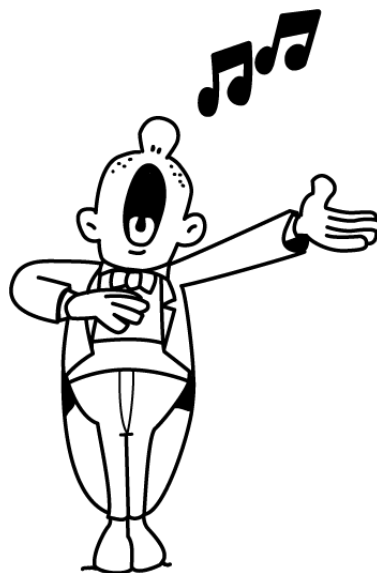

Campaign on Road Safety:

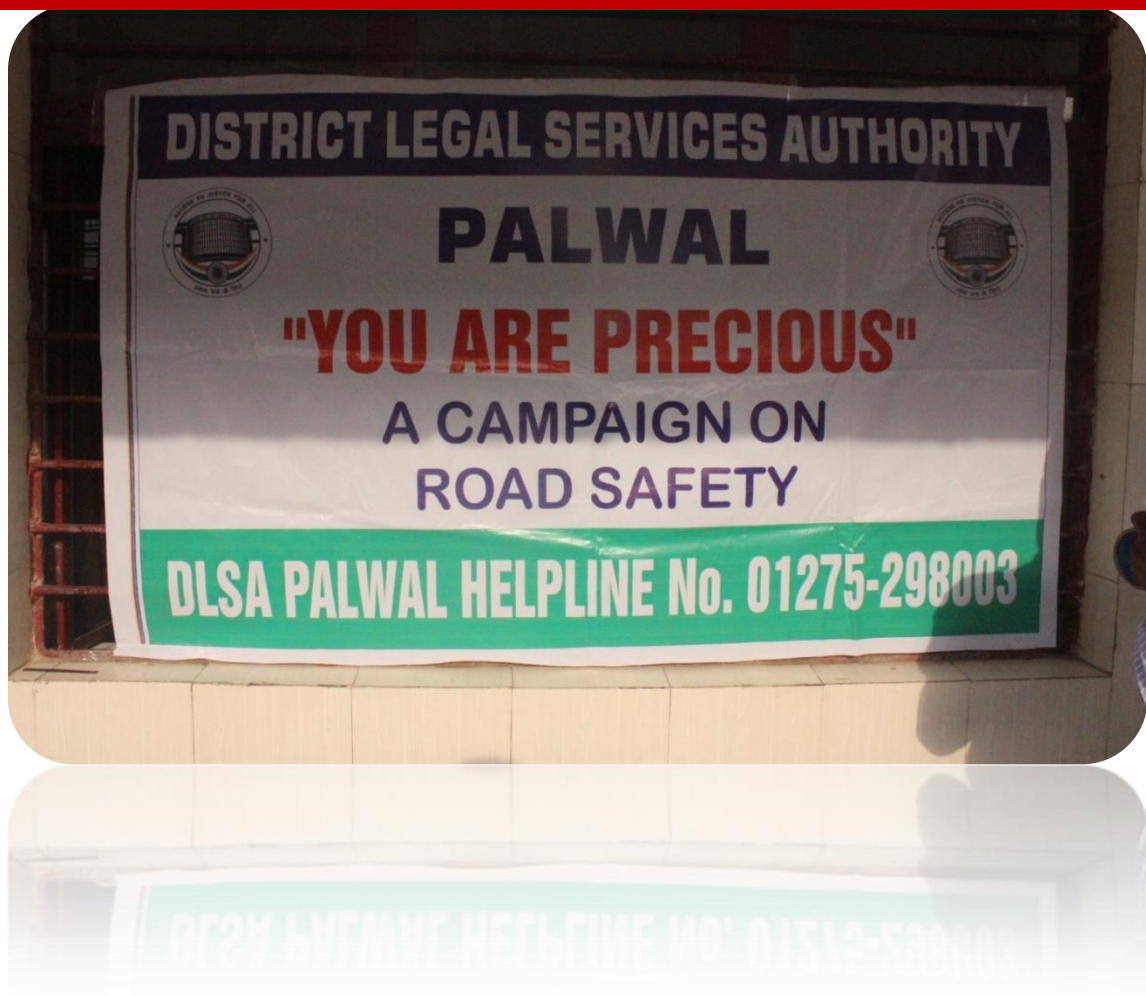
‘Accidents Do Not Happen, They Are Caused.’

Punctuality at school:

Effective use of TENO App:

We attach a lot of importance to students' activities in the class and keep updating parents regarding their ward's performance and progress on a regular basis. Parents are requested to subscribe to the app for the purpose.



Designated persons for picking up students:

Parents are to inform the school office /teacher concerned about who is supposed to pick up their ward/s every day. Remember to alert us whenever any alternative arrangement is made.



Emergency Plan:

In case of an emergency call from the school (which is done only on health grounds) parents are requested to come and meet the principal and take the child back home. It's mandatory for the person (whosoever comes to take the child back home) to produce the I – Card in the office before being given the permission to take the child back home.
