






































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NURTURING GROWTH







The event was a big success, full of happy moments and strong connections. We thank all the mothers for their endless support and love.























































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




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WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY


















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YOGA DAY

VAN MAHOTSAV WEEK


































































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THEATRE/DRAMA COMPETITION




























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HARIYALI TEEJ



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






















































































SANSKRIT WEEK








INDEPENDENCE DAY






RAKSHABANDHAN





































































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JANAMASHTAMI





















NATIONAL SPORTS DAY
