
WORLD POPULATION DAY





These activities are the non –verbal ways to express one's feelings, share ideas as well as effectively contribute to the cause of event.



The school gives due importance to these events and various activities are conducted to create awareness among students by making them a part of celebration of such events.


SAKSHAM NATIONAL COMPETITION - 2018




PARYATAN PARV






HALF YEARLY EXAMINATIONS: 2018-19
